Guidelines for Competition 2024

- 1. Applicant MUST reside in Jackson County or study in Jackson County. This competition is offered to students in grade six through twelve.
- 2. Applicant must be a solo performer (with accompaniment as required by the score.) Recorded accompaniment is only allowed for Dance auditions and Special needs.
- 3. The performer is encouraged to memorize the music, but it is not required for participation.
- 4. Repeats are to be omitted as well as long accompaniment-only passages.
- 5. Two copies (at least one original) of the music are to be provided for the judges with measures numbered on both copies. Any non-original copy is to be shredded/destroyed after the audition to protect copyright law.
- 6. Application must be signed by parent/guardian AND the student's music or dance instructor.
- 7. Two pieces of contrasting style are to be performed to show a range of the performer's abilities. If the piece is a concerto, contrasting movements from the same concerto are accepted.
- 8. Award funds are intended for enrichment study. Private lessons (with a different instructor) will be considered but must be approved by the committee within 2 days of the request. If you cannot find a suitable summer camp or workshop for your field of interest, please submit an alternative activity which could fulfill the intention of this award. For example; college workshops or short term study with a college faculty specialist would be acceptable. The funds are to be used within a year, unless a special request is submitted and accepted by the committee.
- 9. Upon completion of the enrichment activity, a written report evaluating the relative merits of the chosen enrichment funded by the award is to be submitted to the Award Committee Chairperson.
- 10. It is expected that an award winner will perform their pieces at a special program for the Jackson Tuesday Musicale at a date to be determined, later in the current school year.
- 11. An applicant is not eligible to audition after winning two times.
- 12. Applications must arrive <u>by</u> the deadline date (March 6, 2024) to Becky Turk, 4665 N.
